Thank you for your interest in Archway Gallery.

Archway Gallery has been artist-owned and operated since 1976. The operation of the gallery is overseen by an elected Board of Directors (gallery artists) and is managed by all the member-artists. Monthly installations and opening receptions typically occur on the first Friday and Saturday of the month (with exceptions due to holidays). The monthly business meetings occur on Installation Day each month. The gallery is a registered S Corporation and operates under an established set of Bylaws.

Commitments and Responsibilities of Archway Members:

- -Members are expected to work 8 hours each month handling the daily work and sales at the gallery. You may do this as a single 8-hour day, or two 4-hour days by signing up on the monthly work calendar.
- -Members are each assigned jobs such as curator, marketing, gallery work calendar, gallery exhibition calendar, membership, website, mailing list, accounting, etc. Some duties can be performed on gallery Work Days; however, you should expect to spend some hours outside of regular gallery work hours.
- -Members are expected to attend the monthly business meeting (available on Zoom) and assist in the monthly installation. Plan to spend several hours at the gallery on this day.
- -Currently, each member pays \$300.00 each month for rent. All new members must pay a one-time "Buy-In" fee of \$375.00 which is nonrefundable, along with the first and last month's rent. All members sign a contract agreeing to stay in the gallery for at least 1 year and to give at least 3 months' notice if withdrawing from membership.
- -Currently, each member is charged a 15% commission on artwork sales; the commission is reduced to 7 ½% when a member is the Featured Artist as courtesy to offset exhibition expenses. Credit card fees are deducted from an artist's sales. A check for the sale, less commission and credit card charges, is issued to the artist by the gallery. The gallery pays the artists' state sales taxes, but it is the responsibility of each artist to file an annual sales tax return with the Texas state comptroller (with a \$0.00 balance due).
- -Each member is allowed a one-person exhibition approximately every 2 ½ 3 years. The Featured Artist is expected to pay the printing cost of invitations, half of the postage, and miscellaneous other expenses. Archway Gallery maintains an extensive mailing list for the use of the members.

Becoming a Member:

- -Membership is determined by the quality of the artist's work, the current balance of artwork styles and media in the gallery, and the Membership Committee's feedback in reference to the applicant's interview.
- -If you are interested in becoming a member, please fill out an application form and submit it with the required materials to Christie Coker (see below). When an opening develops, you will be asked to bring artwork originals for viewing by our current members, and you will be contacted to arrange an interview.
